

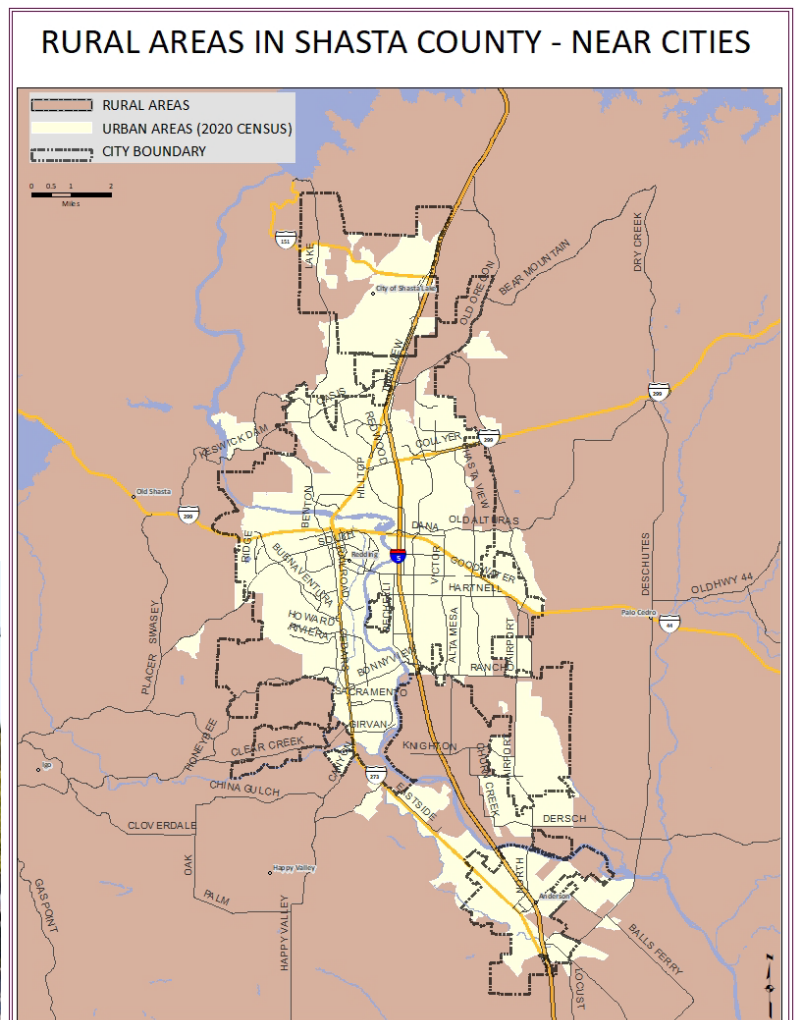


Fact Sheet: Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Funding Program is a formula-based program that provides funding for public transportation in urbanized areas (UZA) as designated by the U.S. Bureau of the Census. The program has distinct requirements and eligibilities for UZAs over and under 200,000 in population. Small UZA recipients (populations of 50,000-200,000) receive approval from their Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), such as SRTA, regarding local programming. Upon approval, recipients can then directly collaborate with the FTA to apply for and deliver projects. Redding Area Bus Authority (RABA) is currently the only recipient of FTA Section 5307 funds apportioned to the Redding UZA.

Eligible Projects:

- Planning Projects.
- Capital Projects (up to 80% of project cost).
- Crime prevention and security equipment.
- Employee Training Expenses
- Operating Assistance (up to 50% of project cost).
- Americans with Disabilities Act complementary paratransit service.
